## Cyber Europe



- a series of EU-level cyber incident and crisis management exercises
- simulations of large-scale cybersecurity incidents that escalate to become cyber crises
- public and private sectors
- EU and EFTA Member States
- standard operating procedures for cross-CSIRT cooperation (Cyber SOPEX)

# ENISA

## ENISA Trainings for Cyber Security Specialists

- online training material (introduced in 2008) useful for organizing a successful training
  - tutorials for teachers
  - handouts for students
- live training courses (~200 cyber security specialists every year)
- covers four main areas:
  - technical
  - operational
  - setting up a CSIRT
  - legal and cooperation

## TRANSITS

- training to both new and experienced CSIRT team personnel, as well as individuals with a bona-fide interest in establishing a CSIRT
  - TRANSITS-I for new recruits
  - TRANSITS-II for more experienced personnel
- with support from ENISA
- governed and reviewed by the TF-CSIRT steering committee

## Locked Shields

- international cyber defence exercise (from 2010)
- the most complex technical live-fire challenge in the world
- simulation of the entire complexity of a massive cyber incident, including strategic decision-making, legal and communication aspects
- Red team vs. Blue Team exercise
- in Estonia
- Locked Shields 2019 - more than 1200 experts from nearly 30 nations
